

"QUICK LIST" OF WORTHINGTON RULES

WORTHINGTON COUNTRY CLUB

All owners and renters must read and abide by all Worthington Country Club Rules and Regulations as stated in the Association and Master Association documents.

The following is a "**Quick List**" of often overlooked Rules that must be followed.

Vehicles

1. Pick up trucks, boats, boat trailers or other trailers of any kind, campers, mobile homes, motor homes, motorcycles, unlicensed or disabled vehicles shall **NOT** be permitted to be parked or stored in Worthington Country Club unless fully enclosed in a structure.
2. The Community speed limit is 25 mph.
3. Only **adult licensed drivers** may operate a golf cart. **Children are not permitted to drive golf carts.**
4. Only WCC residents/members are allowed bar codes on their vehicles for entrance to Worthington.
5. Canvas car covers are not permitted at any time.

Animals/Pets

1. ***Renters in condo and carriage home communities are not permitted to have pets.*** Owners are permitted to have dogs (**limit 25 lbs. or less**) cats or birds.
2. Pets cannot be left tethered outside or on **lanais unattended.**
3. Owners must pick up their pets' waste.
4. Walking dogs on the cart path is not permitted.
5. ***Feeding or molesting*** the alligators is against the law in Florida and is strictly prohibited within Worthington. ***Owners, renters and guests are advised not to walk on lake banks for their own safety.***
6. Swimming, wading, boating or fishing in the lakes is **prohibited.**

Common Facilities

1. Cover-ups must be worn to and from the pool.
2. Men must wear shirts on the tennis courts.
3. Proper attire (including footwear) must be worn on the golf course, practice range, tennis courts, club house and grill room. Jeans are not permitted in these areas. Refer to the club rules for additional clothing information.
4. Children twelve (12) to sixteen (16) must be accompanied by an adult when using the Fitness Center. Children under twelve (12) are not permitted to use the Fitness Center at any time.

- 5. Children sixteen (16) and under must be accompanied by an adult when using the swimming pools.

General

- 1. If you reside in a condo or carriage home community and are contemplating changing your locks any reason, please contact the HOA office to find out whether or not your community has a master lock plan in place. If they do, you will need to contact A " Good" Locksmith to have your new lock master keyed with those of your community.
- 2. All posted rules must be observed by residents, their family members, guests and renters.
- 3. Jogging, skating, skateboarding, bike riding, etc., on the cart path is not permitted.
- 4. Multi-family units must comply with the association documents regarding water, air conditioning and home watch personnel, when leaving for an extended period of time.
- 5. The main gate should be used for entry to the community. If expecting visitors or vendors you must call the guard and provide him/her with this information or your guests/vendors will be turned away. The North gate is closed between 10:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m.
- 6. Trash pick-up schedule for all private residences and carriage homes is Monday. ***Trash containers must not be placed out for pick up prior to 7:00 p.m., Sunday evening.***
- 7. Trash pick-up for all Condo residences may vary during season. Please check with your local association for dumpster and recycling pick-up schedules.
- 8. Recycling schedule for all private residences is Tuesday. ***Recycling containers must not be placed out for pick up prior to 7:00 p.m. Monday evening.*** Recycling schedule for all condo residences is Thursday.
- 9. All cardboard boxes must be broken down before being placed in the recycling or trash containers. For pick-up of large items such as cabinets, appliances, etc., you must call Veolia at 239-334-1224 to schedule a pick up.
- 10. ComCast is the cable carrier within Worthington. Basic cable is included in your Master Association dues. Contact ComCast directly at 239-432-9277 to report service problems, questions regarding internet service or other additional service.

It is my responsibility to make my family members, guests and renters aware of this information so that they may also abide by these and all other rules and regulations as set forth in our community and Master Association documents.
